THE MINNEAPOLIS-ST. PAUL CHAPTER

The activities of the Chapter are planned within volunteer committees, each led by a Committee Chairperson and Co-Chairperson. All Chapter members are welcome to serve on a committee or committees of their choice. Committees include Awards, Certification,
Communications, Product Event, Membership, Programs, and Golf Event.

LOCAL AEC INDUSTRY NETWORK

The Minneapolis-St. Paul Chapter is a network of dedicated building professionals striving to ensure construction projects are delivered with industry accepted standards, specifications and materials. Education is an important part of CSI's mission. Monthly meeting programs, technical workshops, and continuing education programs provide construction professionals with regular updates on building code changes, new product development, and construction practices. The Chapter also assists the National organization by providing classes to prepare candidates for certification examinations, and sponsors the annual "Introduction to Construction Documents" workshop.
