Region and Chapter Leaders have already been informed and Members have begun being updated. The Component Value Task Force (CVTF) spent many months of work with the input for this change. In summary beginning July 1, 2022, members will only belong to one**Home Chapter** which will get their chapter dues; however, you can still participate in other chapters as their policies allow. 
