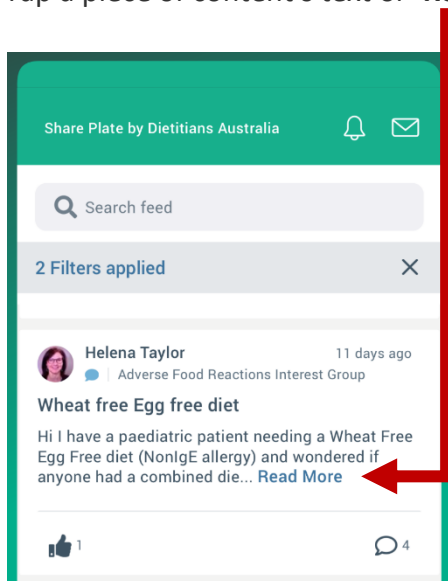


# Interact with Feed content

As you're browsing the Feed, you'll likely find content you want to explore further or interact with in some way. Let's take a look at the various ways this can be done.



## View content



To keep Feed content manageable, text is truncated to a maximum number of characters. Tap a piece of content's text or **'Read More'** link to view the whole post.



## Interacting with content in the Feed

The table below outlines how you can interact with content in the Feed.

Icon/Name	Actions	Description
 <p><b>Discussions</b></p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Thumbs up</b> - Tap to "like" the content.</li> <li><b>Speech bubble</b> - Tap to view the full discussion thread. From there, you can write a reply, as well as like and respond to existing replies.</li> </ul>
