Exhibit Setup

Exhibitors are responsible for providing the required information to setup their exhibit by the due dates. Detailed information will be sent to the person listed as the contact on the exhibit reservation form.

Exhibit Fees and Payment

Payment in U.S. dollars is required by Dec. 18, 2020 to participate.

Selection of Exhibitors

Only firms and organizations whose services and products are appropriately related to the purpose of IDEA shall be permitted to exhibit. IDEA reserves the right to decline or prohibit any exhibit which in its judgement is inappropriate, this reservation being all-inclusive as to person, things, printed matter, products and conduct. No virtual booths may be shared or sublet without prior written permission of IDEA. Failure to comply is deemed cause for cancellation of the space.

Cancellations

The purchase of a virtual booth is nonrefundable.

Exhibitor Registration

Exhibitors must follow the instructions to register exhibit personnel online. Each paid exhibit company will receive a discount code to pay and register as an attendee once registration is open.

Liability and Indemnification
