
#### **IDEA Connect**

# **Membership Categories**

#### **Utility - District Energy**

Owns, operates or is planning a public or private district energy system. Each operating utility system of a parent (holding company with multiple systems) is considered a utility.

Annual dues are based on previous calendar year combined annual thermal sales (steam, hot water & chilled water) at the operating utility unit level. Does not include electricity sales.

### Physical Plant/Campus Energy System .......\$1,290

Owns a central district energy plant at a public or private college, university, institution, research facility, healthcare facility or hospital, airport or military base. Does not include private contractor operators of campus energy systems (see ESCO) *Entitled to 8 listed representatives*.

#### Manufacturer/Supplier ...... \$3,475

Physically produces or sells equipment or supplies and materials for the industry, including manufacturer's representatives. Entitled to 6 listed representatives.

#### Non-Profit Organizations/Government Agencies...... \$525

Non-profit associations or government agencies engaged in advocacy or education in North America or beyond. Government applies to federal, state, provincial, municipal, or local governments or government agencies involved in evaluation, regulation, planning and/or policy related to district energy/CHP. Does not include government-owned or operated district energy systems. *Entitled to 2 listed representatives*.

#### Service Providers to the Industry

(Not Manufacturers or Equipment Suppliers)

#### Energy Service Companies / CHP/ Waste to Energy/ Energy Efficiency/ Renewable Assets

This category is for publicly or privately-owned Energy Service Companies (ESCOs) or Design Build Own Operate Maintain (DBOOM) organizations that develop, finance, deliver, own, manage or operate a district energy system, combined heat & power (CHP), waste to energy, or renewable asset for public or private clients, including organizations that provide energy efficiency services, energy conservation measures, energy purchasing or procurement services. This may include utility company subsidiaries. Turnover is based on prior year gross revenue at the company headquarters level.
