The Renewables and Environmental Regulatory Institute (RERI) and Belgrade Open School (BOŠ) are inviting you to take part in consultative sessions on NECP development in Serbia, with a particular focus on public participation and implications of the energy transition for the economy, environment and livelihoods of local communities.

### Purpose and scope of the consultations

In 2021 RERI and BOŠ launched an initiative for a transparent and participatory process of drafting the *National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP)* of the Republic of Serbia. We believe that it is important to enable the public to participate in the drafting of this document at an early stage, while all options are open. In addition, involving the public in the drafting of planning documents is a legal obligation.

At this consultative forum, we want to acquaint civil society and the academic community with the progress in developing this plan and discuss economic and social implications of proposed scenarios for the energy transition.
