#### What is the submission deadline?

The deadline is April 1, 2024

#### Do you accept abstracts that have been presented at other conferences?

Yes, you may submit your abstract for consideration.

#### Do I have to be a member to submit an abstract? What about if it's accepted?

No, authors are not required to be members but encouraged.

# If my poster is accepted, do I receive any discounts or financial assistance to attend the conference?

The primary author will receive their conference registration for \$25. Student nurses are free but will not receive CEUs. (after submission you will receive a discount code)

#### Am I required to register for conference to present my work?

If accepted, at least one author must register and attend the conference, you will be given 2 minutes at the conference to present your work along with your poster on display.

# What format of poster presentation is accepted?

Posters can be either digital or print- however if in digital format only, the poster will not be able to be displayed throughout the entire conference but will be on display during your presentation.

# **Poster Abstracts Information Categories**

Evidence-Based Practice: should include information about the process and results of identifying and implementing evidence guiding practice change that is aimed at advancing clinical practice.

Quality Improvement: should include information about the project aims, documentation of improvement, and clear delineations of changes that sustain improved practice.

Research: should include information about the process and results of a study aimed at generating new knowledge relative to a specific research question to advance clinical practice.

Conflict of Interest and Financial Disclosure Authors are able to control the content of educational activities and must disclose whether or not there is a conflict of interest. All conflicts of interest, including potential ones, will be reviewed by ENA prior to the conference and the primary author will be notified if anything further needs to be addressed.
