

IASBO - NIU Partnership

- Long-term partnership Over 20 continuous cohorts
- Consistent interaction between NIU faculty and instructors, Illinois ASBO leadership, and practitioners in the field across Illinois
- Illinois ASBO and NIU both partner with ISBE and with other statewide professional organizations
- Membership in Illinois ASBO
 - Professional Development: Annual Conference, Seminars, Mentoring
 - Networking: Peer to Peer, Committees, Groups, and Organizations
 - Resources: Archives, Publications, ASBO Library



IASBO - NIU Partnership

- This program requires that participants be admitted, have membership, and be in good standing with Illinois Association of School Business Officials until completion
- Due to the nature of the program structure, students do not receive a 1098T
- Illinois ASBO Dues: \$445 per credit hour
 - \$1,335 for a 3-credit hour class
- Unfortunately, NIU Tuition Waivers cannot be used for this program

- Experienced instructors balance practical and theoretical knowledge
- Successful completion opens a path to EdD
- Once the endorsement is obtained, students may apply to the EdS program and earn their Superintendent Endorsement



Program Schedule

6-semester program

- Typically 6-8 credit hours per semester
- Convenient mix of asynchronous online course delivery and 2-5 synchronous sessions per course
- In-person class weekends at start and end of the semester at NIU Naperville
 - Fridays from 6 9 PM (one class)
 - Saturdays from 9 AM Noon (other class)
