Think Preventative – Check your District's Payroll

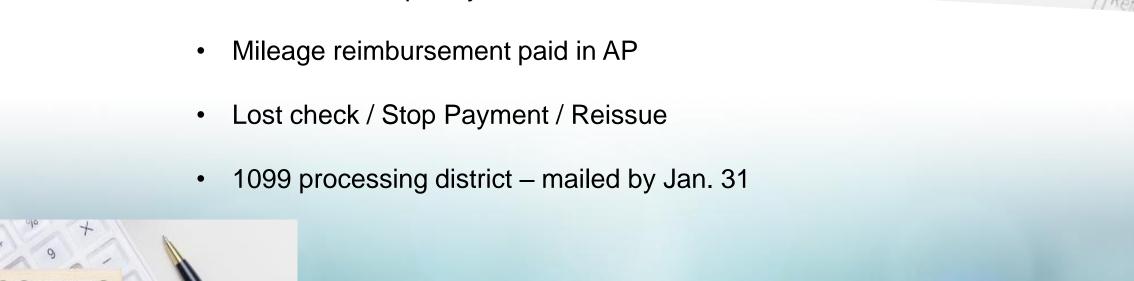

- W9 available on District website
- Manage new vendors
- Remind vendors of payment terms
 - State Prompt Payment Act 30 ILCS 540









AR Customer Service

Examples

- Damage to district property
- Transportation cost split with another district
- Damage to a technology device
- Facility Rental Invoices

Effective Strategies

- Timely billing
- Friendly Reminders
- Arrange Payment Plan
- Consistent Follow Up

Student Fees



- Often handled at building level then escalated to Business Office
- Payment plans are often effective with follow-up calls, monthly emails, texts
- HB4243 signed into law by Governor Pritzker May 2022*
 - Prohibits schools and school districts withholding a student's transcripts or diploma of ANY unpaid balance owed the school





Vendor – Assist the CFO/CSBO

- Review and submit pay application requests
- Review and approve invoices sent to District
- Process the invoices
- Process pay requests
- Provide necessary information on finances, facilities to vendors



Vendor - Perspective

Vendors rely upon the information provided by the business office to bid, negotiate, and award projects.





Vendor - Perspective

Vendors are not banks. Delays in processes invoices and pay requests can have adverse affects on the vendors. Missing a deadline or delaying an invoice even a week, can cause much longer delays for the vendor.
