

Payroll- How do we Pay? Marengo

- Paper Timesheets Color Coded
- Each School Bookkeeper invoices other schools weekly and quarterly
- Route Pay (hourly), Trip Pay (15 min increment)
- Guaranteed Weekly Fueling and Cleaning
 - 30 minutes per week for fueling and cleaning automatically
- Wash Sweep Fuel beyond 30 min guarantee \$14.75
- Transportation meetings \$14.75
- Refresher Course Stipend \$55.00
- Summer School only High School 2024 BOOKKEEPERS CONFERENC
- Only Full time 30 hr have Benefits

Payroll- How do we Pay? Marengo

- Three Districts share Bus Contract, Transportation Coordinator
- Fleet Information
 - 35 total buses 74 passenger buses all diesel with air brakes
 - 10 Transport Vans (used for Special Education and Homeless Student routes)
- Drivers are employed by each district but are scheduled through a single Transportation
 Office,
- There is 1 full time/ part time mechanic shared between districts
- Marengo High School (2 drivers)
 - 660 Students
- Marengo Union Consolidated Elementary 165 (22 drivers)
 - 1,058 Students
- Riley Elementary D18 (9 drivers)

Payroll- How do we Pay? Mokena

- Automated Timekeeping System
 - True Time within Skyward System
 - Employee ID Code
 - Digital timeclock
 - Weighted Over/Time Calculations
- Payroll Calendar
- How we used to do things...
- Why we changed
 - Minimize administrative errors
 - Burden on timekeeper rather than payroll

Payroll- How do we Pay? Mokena

- Fleet Information
 - 13 buses; 74 passenger; gas and diesel
 - Purchased buses
- 10 Full Time Drivers
- 1 Full Time Sub 2 On-Call Subs
- 3 School buildings; one Parochial; one Private School

Payroll – Trip Rates, Overtime, Holidays and Weekends - Marengo

- Rates
 - Route Hourly Regular Pay starting at \$22.75
 - Regular Day scheduled Special Education Van Routes \$28.45
 - Day Trip \$18.77, Night Trip \$18.77, Weekend Trip \$18.77,
 Overnight off-duty Rate \$ stipend amount based on trip
 - Wash Sweep Fuel beyond 30 min guarantee \$14.75
 - Transportation meetings \$14.75
 - Refresher Course Stipend \$55.00

Payroll – Trip Rates, Overtime, Holidays and Weekends - Marengo

- Overtime
 - Drivers select/bid on trips they want and then using a round robin process they are awarded extra-curricular trips?
 - This process is completed by the Transportation Director and Superintendents have access to the selection documents to monitor the process?

Payroll – Trip Rates, Overtime, Holidays and Weekends - Mokena

- Trip Rates
 - Route Rate Regular Pay \$21.68
 - Day Trip \$22.46; Night Trip \$24.32; Weekend Trip \$27.37
- Overtime Weighted in Skyward
 - How is it determined?
 - Over 40 hours per week
 - Pay at 1.5 per hour
 - Who monitors?

Payroll – Trip Rates, Overtime, Holidays and Weekends

Type of Pay	Marengo	Mokena
Starting Rate	\$22.75	\$21.68
Day Trip	\$18.77	\$22.46
Night Trip	\$18.77	\$24.32
Weekend	\$18.77	\$27.37
Off-Duty Rate (Overnight Trips)	(\$ Stipend based on trip)	
Training Rate	\$22.75	\$21.68

Payroll – Guaranteed Minimums

- Employee Handbook guarantees drivers and subs a 5 hour day
- Transportation Coordinator makes sure drivers get the guaranteed 5 hours
- Payroll is a double check on the 5 hours
- How the 5 hours is protected
 - Drivers/Subs must be working for the entire 5 hours
 - Drivers/Subs are driving, cleaning, fueling, or paperwork



Payroll - Benefits

- IMRF
 - 600 hours
 - Mandated payroll deduction of 4.5%
 - District contribution changes every year, approximately 10-11%, final rate notice in December for next year
 - Mokena all qualify
 - Marengo used to be about 50/50 that qualified but this year almost 100% with equalization of route times & shared trips.
- Non-IMRF
 - Less than 600 hours





Payroll – Benefits

- Benefits at Mokena 159
 - All drivers receive 20K life insurance paid by district portable
 - Sick, Personal, and Condolence Days
 - Four (4) Paid Holidays
- Marengo Insurance 4 driver only, but more with other school employment like kitchen etc.
- Insurance varies by district
 - ACA 1230 hours for coverage 30 hours per week for 41 weeks
 - Historically, had to add time in the kitchen to meet minimum hour 2024 BOOKKEEPERS CONFEREN

Incentives - Mokena

- Reimbursement for training
 - Must complete training
 - Must become fully licensed driver with District
- Reimbursement for licensing cost
- Quarterly Driver Appreciation breakfast or luncheon
- PTA sponsored staff appreciation day
 - All staff and students wear yellow for bus drivers
 - PTA sponsors a lunch for drivers
- Monthly Team Meetings
- Daily Water and Snacks



Incentives - Marengo

- Reimbursement for training
 - Must complete training
- Paid Refresher Classes with pizza provided
- Bi-Annual Driver Appreciation breakfast or luncheon
- School Sponsored driver appreciation week
 - Treats throughout the week
 - Everyone given a Drivers Jacket at Breakfast
- Periodic treats in the bus garage
- Meal reimbursement during trips
- Annual physical reimbursement


