

## **ACGME MILESTONES**

Each domain in boldface is a Clinical Competency. Below each Competency are the specific Milestones.

In total, these represent a “road map” to becoming a physician qualified to practice independently.

### **PATIENT CARE**

PC1: Gathers and synthesizes essential and accurate information to define each patient’s clinical problems

PC2: Develops and achieves a comprehensive management plan for each patient

PC3: Manages patients with progressive responsibility and independence

PC4: Demonstrates skill in performing procedures.

PC5: Requests and provides consultative care

### **MEDICAL KNOWLEDGE**

MK1: Demonstrates clinical knowledge

MK2: Demonstrates knowledge of diagnostic testing and procedures

### **SYSTEMS BASED PRACTICE**

SBP1: Works effectively within an inter-professional team (e.g. peers, consultants, nursing, ancillary professionals and other support personnel)

SBP2: Recognizes system error and advocates for system improvement

SBP3: Identifies forces that impact the cost of healthcare and advocates for, and practices cost-effective care

SBP4: Transitions patients effectively within and across health delivery systems

### **PRACTICE BASED LEARNING**

PBL1: Monitors practice with a goal for improvement

PBL2: Learns and improves via performance audit

PBL3: Learns and improves via feedback

PBL4: Learns and improves at the point of care

### **PROFESSIONALISM**

PRO1: Has professional and respectful interactions with patients, caregivers and members of the inter-professional team (e.g. peers, consultants, nursing, ancillary professionals and support personnel)

PRO2: Accepts responsibility and follows through on tasks

PRO3: Responds to each patient’s unique characteristics and needs

PRO4: Exhibits integrity and ethical behavior in professional conduct

### **INTERPERSONAL AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS**

ICS1: Communicates effectively with patients and caregivers

ICS2: Communicates effectively in inter-professional teams (e.g. peers, consultants, nursing, ancillary professionals and other support personnel)

ICS3: Demonstrates appropriate utilization and completion of health records
