<u>Scholarship Amounts</u>: Scholarships will start at \$1,000 dollars with several scholarships given out.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements: Both full-time and part-time students are eligible to apply. Undergraduate students must carry at least six (6) credits during the Spring 2024 semester and plan on enrolling as a student in Fall 2024 (for scholarship payout you must be enrolled in at least six credit hours Fall 2024). Graduate students must carry at least three (3) credits during the Spring 2024 semester and plan on enrolling as a student in Fall 2024). Students must carry at least three credit hours Fall 2024. (for scholarship payout you must be enrolled in at least three credit hours Fall 2024). Students who are enrolled in the following major course curriculums such as Management Accounting, Financial Accounting, Taxation and Audit are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Criteria for selection will be based on the following:

- 1. Academic merit
- 2. Participation in leadership activities in either school or community
- 3. Strength of recommendation letter and your application cover letter

Application deadline is February 28th at 11:59 PM MT. Winners will be announced in April at an in-person event. Additional event details will be sent to scholarship applicants.

To apply, complete the application form below and submit the following information:

- 1.) Submit a current resume that includes:
 - a.) Education and employment history
 - b.) Participation in school, community and/or leadership activities
 - c.) Awards
 - d.) Other information you deem pertinent.
- Copy of your transcript that includes grades from the most recently completed term
- 3.) Recommendation letter from an employer or member of the academic community that has known you for at least one year (cannot be a relative)
- 4.) An application cover letter of 400 words or less addressing your career objectives, why you are applying for this scholarship and how your values and goals align with the IMA. For more information about the IMA, please visit imanet.org
