Scholarship Amounts: Scholarships will start at \$500 dollars with several scholarships given out. The Denver/Centennial IMA awarded \$10,000 in scholarships in 2021!

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements: Both full- and part-time students are eligible to apply. Undergraduate students must carry at least six (6) credits during the Spring 2022 semester and plan on enrolling as a student in Fall 2022 (for scholarship payout you must be enrolled in at least six credit hours Fall 2022). Graduate students must carry at least three (3) credits during the Spring 2022 semester and plan on enrolling as a student in Fall 2022 (for scholarship payout you must be enrolled in at least three credit hours Fall 2022).

Criteria for selection will be based on the following:

1. Academic merit
2. Participation in leadership activities in either school or community
3. Strength of recommendation letter and your application cover letter.

Winners will be announced on February 24th. Additional event details will be sent to scholarship applicants.

To apply, complete the application form below and submit the following information:

- 1.) Submit a current resume that includes:
 - a.) Education and employment history
 - b.) Participation in school, community and/or leadership activities
 - c.) Awards
 - d.) Other information you deem pertinent
- 2.) Transcript that includes grades from the most recently completed term
- 3.) Recommendation letter from an employer or member of the academic community that has known you for at least one year (cannot be a relative)
- 4.) An application cover letter of 400 words or less addressing your career objectives, why you are applying for this scholarship and how your values and goals align with the IMA. For more information about the IMA, please visit imanet.org.
