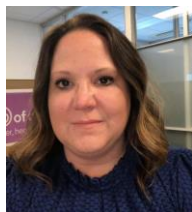


Member Spotlight

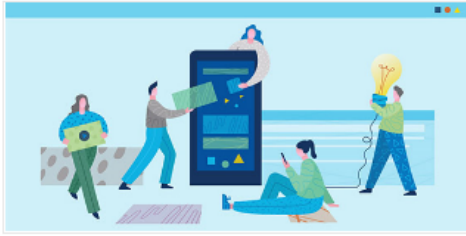

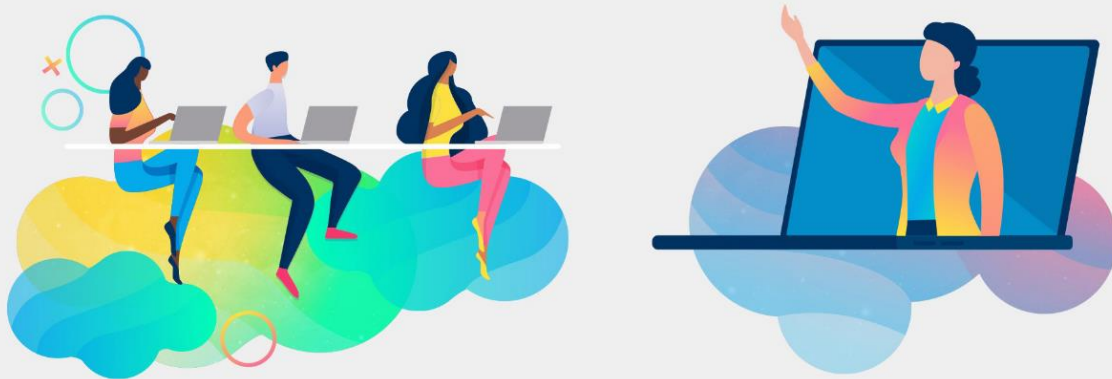
