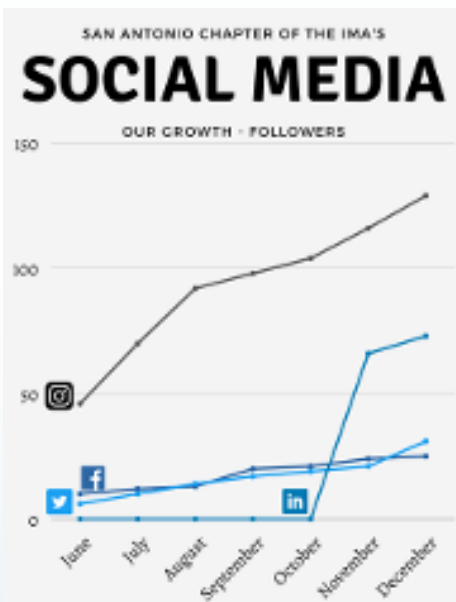

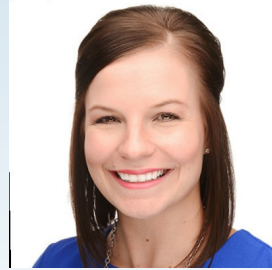

How? By telling us your zip code! =)

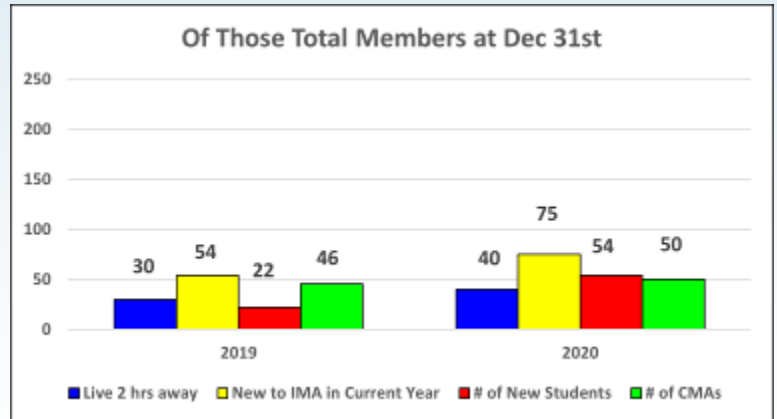
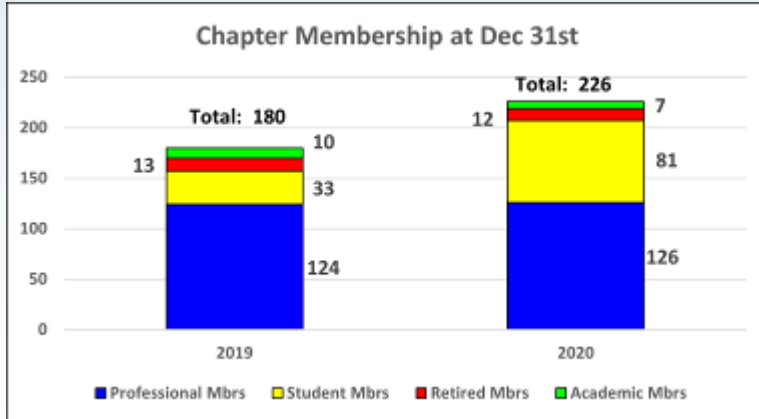
