Use Snapchat to Engage Students

Snapchat is a camera application for mobile devices that enables users to communicate visually by using pictures or short videos referred to as “snaps.” While there are several social media platforms (such

as Facebook and Instagram) that allow users to share pictures, Snapchat is unique because its pictures and videos are deleted automatically once the recipient views them. Because content is shared quickly and easily, often in real time, Snapchat is a widely used app for sharing images, especially for younger social media users.

Recent research has shown that 77% of college students use Snapchat, with 50% of college students using Snapchat to communicate daily. In 2017, Snapchat became the most popular social media network of U.S. teenagers. Snapchat is an alternative way to connect with students in addition to traditional methods such as email and a learning management system.
