Pre-Tech Session - "What we've learned from the Opiates crisis in Ohio"

Karen Abel Jepsen, OCPC Prevention Consultant



Karen Abel Jepsen is a Prevention Consultant and subject matter expert in strategies to promote behavioral health, wellness and resiliency.

She worked for Domestic Violence Project, Inc. in Canton for 22 years as their Prevention Director, raising awareness in the community about family violence. She was the first in Stark County to design and pilot a dating violence prevention program for teens and survey adolescents about physical and emotional abuse in their lives. She went on to manage evidence-based substance use prevention programs in the schools and chair the Drug Free Stark County coalition.

Currently, Karen is providing training and consultation in the behavioral health field. She volunteers on the Stark County Opiate Task Force and the Suicide Prevention Coalition. In addition, Karen has developed her thrifty love for

recycling and repurposing into a side business helping folks bring order to their homes. As the Clutter Coach, she assists

others in making space within their homes and hopefully within their lives. This time of year she patiently waits for the spring seed catalog to arrive with dreams of soon digging in the dirt of her garden.

CMA Mentoring Program

The IMA Akron Chapter is proud to offer its members a mentoring program to assist CMA candidates with strategies to pass the CMA exam. The IMA Akron CMA Mentoring Program will encourage networking and provide career development opportunities designed to help CMA candidates (mentees) and other members (mentors) in our chapter to form valuable mentoring relationships. The success of this program will rely on volunteers to serve as mentors. Mentoring can take place online, by phone, or in person at Akron chapter events or other locations.

Mentees and mentors will be matched based on the needs of the mentee and the availability of the mentors. The ideal mentor for this CMA focused program would be an individual who has obtained the CMA certification and / or who has recently passed one or both parts of the newer two part CMA exam structure. All individuals who are currently enrolled in the CMA program and studying for the CMA exam are encouraged to enroll as a mentee. In addition, individuals who are undecided about obtaining the CMA certification and would like additional information or guidance are encouraged to enroll.

The CMA Designation - The CMA (Certified Management Accountant) is the advanced professional certification specifically designated to measure the accounting and financial management skills that drive business performance. Achieving the CMA credential demonstrates your mastery of financial planning, analysis, control, and decision support, as well as professional ethics.
