President's Message

East Bay Chapter Members and Friends,

Hope that everyone is continuing to be safe and well during this time. Many believe that we will soon begin to see more favorable trends related to the pandemic (i.e. lower number of cases, lower positivity rates, etc...) as a result of the social practices that have been put in to place as well as hope on the horizon for a vaccine. Until then, stay safe and remain diligent.

On the business front, not sure if you noticed, but there was an interesting article in the August issue of the IMA's Strategic Finance magazine. The title of the article is <u>Covid Bends Future Technology</u>, written by Michael Castelluccio. The article speaks about an annual report that has been produced by Citigroup and Oxford since 2015 on the current state and future expectations for technology at work. This year's report (interestingly enough) was titled "A New World of Remote Work". And its central theme, of course, is how "COVID-19 is creating enormous societal disruptions but also new opportunities to experiment, both for business and for governments." The overriding question being asked is "what will the post-COVID-19 work environment look like?"

The study found that as we prepare to return to the "office", three out of five workers would prefer to remain at / work from home. Further, 24% of the occupations in the United States can now be performed remotely, and those occupations employ 52% of the workforce. Many key industries such as education technology, telecom services, and software are being transformed as we speak. If the shift to working from home were to become permanent, other related markets and industries could be affected as well (e.g. energy, commercial real estate, travel, etc...).

While no one can for certain predict what the future will hold for us, it is evident that the current pandemic has forced mass adoption of existing technologies. And, you can stay current with these changes in technology by exploring IMA's Technology & Analytics Center (see link below). The Center has many educational resources such as online courses, articles, webinars, research, blogs, and podcasts that are focused on key technology and data analytic trends affecting the accounting and finance profession. Candidate Experience - It Matters!



My niece has been engaged in a job search and I have been guiding her through the process. It has been eye opening to see how the process is handled from the job seeker's perspective. She has applied to sixteen different jobs and has completed four

interviews. Following is a breakdown of her experience:

Company #1

She completed a telephone interview with a Corporate Recruiter, and she was passing her resume to the hiring manager at a different location. She promised to follow up the following Tuesday one way or the other if they were going to move forward. No response. My niece followed up to see if there was an update. No response. Finally, two weeks later, an email comes through thanking her for her time, but they have filled the role.

Takeaway: Do not commit to contacting a prospective employee and not follow through. Instead, have your hiring process set up to communicate automatically at certain intervals within the hiring process (scheduling interviews, no interest, etc.).

In September 2019, the SEC charged Marvell Technology Group, Ltd with misleading disclosure violations to investors when it engaged in an undisclosed revenue management scheme in order to meet publicly issued revenue guidance. Charles Hecht, partner at Balestriere Fariello, starts our segment by giving us his thoughts on SEC crackdowns on earnings management.
