President's Message

East Bay Chapter Members and Friends,

An article in the March edition of our Strategic Finance magazine caught my eye this past month. Partly because, with Spring in the air, my mind was thinking about (among other things) the start of another baseball season. The article is titled 'Be An "ACE", written by Nick Lebredo. The acronym "ACE" stands for Attitude, Character, Effort, and it is the author's daily "mantra". Here are some excerpts.

In almost every context, "ace" is a word that relates to achieving excellence. An exceptional aviator is called an ace. In baseball, a team's best pitcher is referred to as their ace. As leaders in the work-place, we are most effective when we focus our energy on what's within our control. Unfortunately, it's human nature to become upset or anxious about things we can't control. In every such situation, repeating the mantra "ACE" may help us to stay focused on what's important and what we can control instead (i.e. our Attitude, our Character, and our Effort). Here's how:

Attitude – be positive, be optimistic, be a "proactive realist". Hoping things will turn out for the best isn't enough. We need to be solution-oriented rather than problem-oriented. Ask the question, "How can I make things better?" Focus energy on what we can change and improve!

Character – Our character can be our best asset or biggest liability. Each of us has at least two characters: who we are at present and who we aspire to be. Having the courage to do our duty is at the core of character. If we make a mistake (and we will), then we need to acknowledge it, take responsibility, and move forward strengthened by the new knowledge gained from the experience.

Effort - There will always be others who may have more natural talent or be in better circumstances than us. Our starting points in life aren't equal. But what we do between the beginning and the end is up to each of us. So, what's the key to achieving our goals? Effort and persistence. Hard work beats talent when talent doesn't work hard.

The Chapter was chartered July 1, 1966 as Alameda County – South Chapter (#207) with a charter membership of 82. In 1990, the Chapter went through a reorganization, moving its meeting locations and changed its name to Amador Valley. The new name reflected the new geographical location (South Contra Costa County and South Alameda County) of chapter members and meetings.

On July 1, 2014, the Amador Valley Chapter and the Oakland - East Bay Chapter merged. The Merged Chapter retained the Oakland - East Bay Chapter Number for historical significance. The Merged Chapter is named the East Bay - Northern California Chapter as there was an historical East Bay Chapter in IMA history and our members are located in Western and Southern Contra Costa County and Alameda County.

"3 Hiring Tips in a Tight Candidate Market" Link



Hiring for your team is always a daunting process especially in a tight candidate market. Today, hiring managers are facing the challenge of finding qualified candidates given the low unemployment rate as well as fewer people (between Baby Boomers and Generation X). 1) Company Attraction

Also, once hired make sure you keep them excited about joining your company. You can take them to lunch, let them know their laptop/phone have been ordered, share press releases, etc.

CMA (Certified Management Accountant) Certification Exam to Be Updated With an Increased Focus on Technology in January 2020

ICMA® (The Institute of Certified Management Accountants), the certification division of IMA® (The Institute of Management Accountants), announced that it is making changes to its CMA® (Certified Management Accountant) exam. The updates to the exam are being made to ensure the CMA remains relevant in the ever-evolving environment of the management accounting profession. The changes will be effective January 1, 2020.

The new CMA exam will be changed in both parts but remain a two-part exam. Each part will be a four-hour test with 100 multiple-choice questions and two essays. IMCA is saying that what will change is some of the content:

- Part 1 of the exam will contain a new section called Technology and Analytics. This section, which will comprise 15% of Part 1, will test new
 topics like information systems, data governance, technology-enabled finance transformation, and data analytics. To accommodate this
 new material, content from other sections will be reduced. Part 1 of the exam will also have a new title: "Financial Planning, Performance,
 and Analytics."
- Part 2 of the exam will also be revised and include greater emphasis on ethics and strategic decision making. It will have a new title as well: "Strategic Financial Management."

The Strategic Finance Magazine has an article "KEEPING THE CMA RELEVANT" which provides background on why the CMA Exam is changing.
