

## Recent Content Services on Cloud updates and Announcements:

### October 10th, 2019

Business Automation Content Services on Cloud has been updated with new capabilities for the Q3 2019 release! New capabilities include:

- Support for IBM Cloud Object Storage (ICOS) Immutable Object Storage. Now clients can configure WORM storage and set retention policies that are propagated to the storage tier to prevent inadvertent deletion or modification. Note that this capability is not available in the Federal data centers.
- The Content Services GraphQL API Technology Preview is now available as part of Content Services on Cloud.
- A new API usage report allows clients to easily view their API consumption over a given period of time.
- IBM Content Collector for Files and IBM Content Collector for SAP can now be configured to use Content Services on Cloud. More information is available [here](#).
- The User Portal interface has been refreshed with an updated theme.
- Client tools can now be downloaded directly rather than linking to FixCentral, reducing the number of clicks and streamlining the process.

Business Automation Content Services on Cloud has been updated with new capabilities for the Q2 2019 release! New capabilities include:

- An Enterprise Records add-on option providing market-leading records management capabilities, allowing you to streamline records-based activities and enforce compliance with retention policies, with or without user participation.

### April 5th, 2019

Business Automation Content Services on Cloud has been updated with new capabilities for the Q1 2019 release! New capabilities include:

- Enhanced self-service capabilities in the BACSoC User Portal to support application development within BACSoC:
  - Ability to upload custom Content Navigator plug-ins
  - Ability to download log files for CPE, CSS, ICN, CMIS
  - Ability to restart containers
- .NET package allows integration with .NET-based applications, including Datacap and CEBIT (Content Engine Bulk Import Tool)
  - CEBIT tool is now available for download via the BACSoC User Portal. From the 'Content Platform Engine Administration Tools' tile, follow the prompts to log into Fix Central where you can download the zip package.
