
- Realizing the synergy between the Software AG product lines

## Simplify Security Configuration

- Default Java keystore is now generated by the server
- Https for XHTML client is available out of the box
- Java client SSL support has been simplified
- Mainframe SSL no longer requires importing a certificate

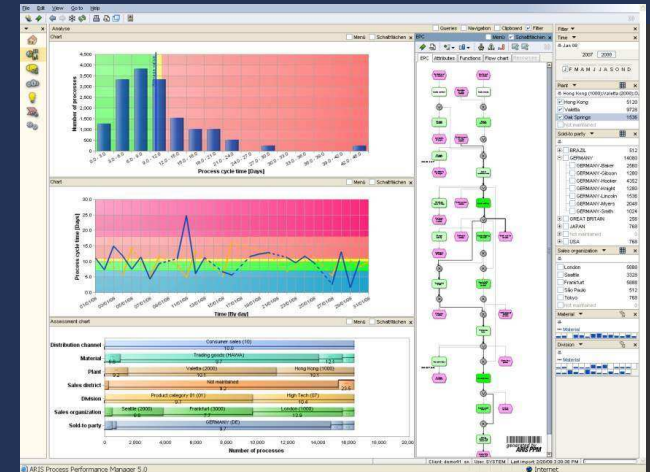

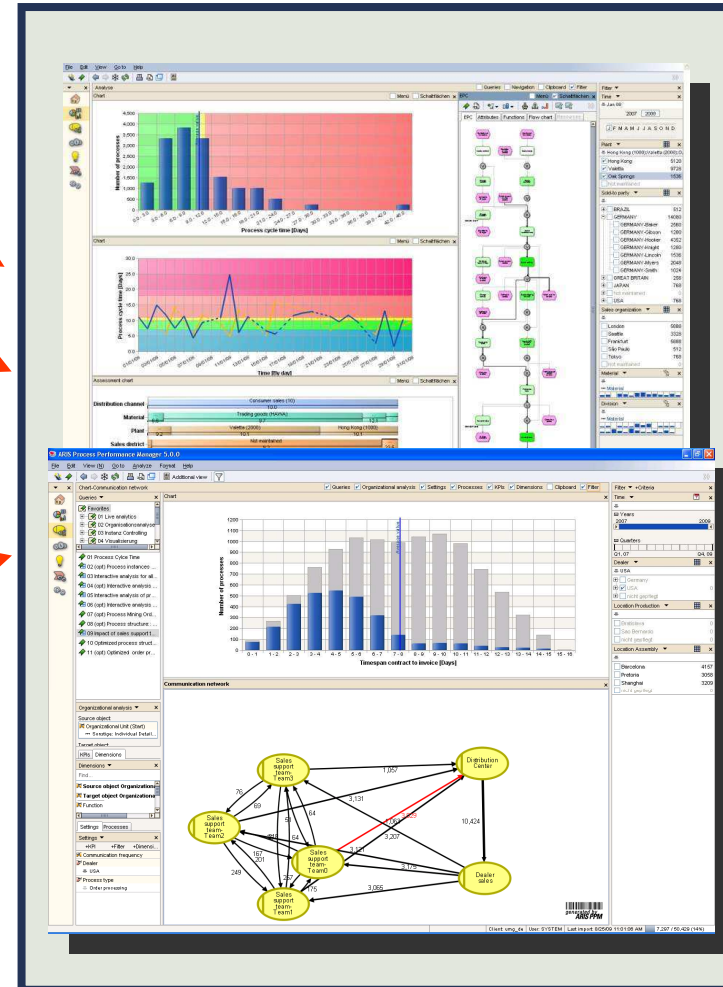

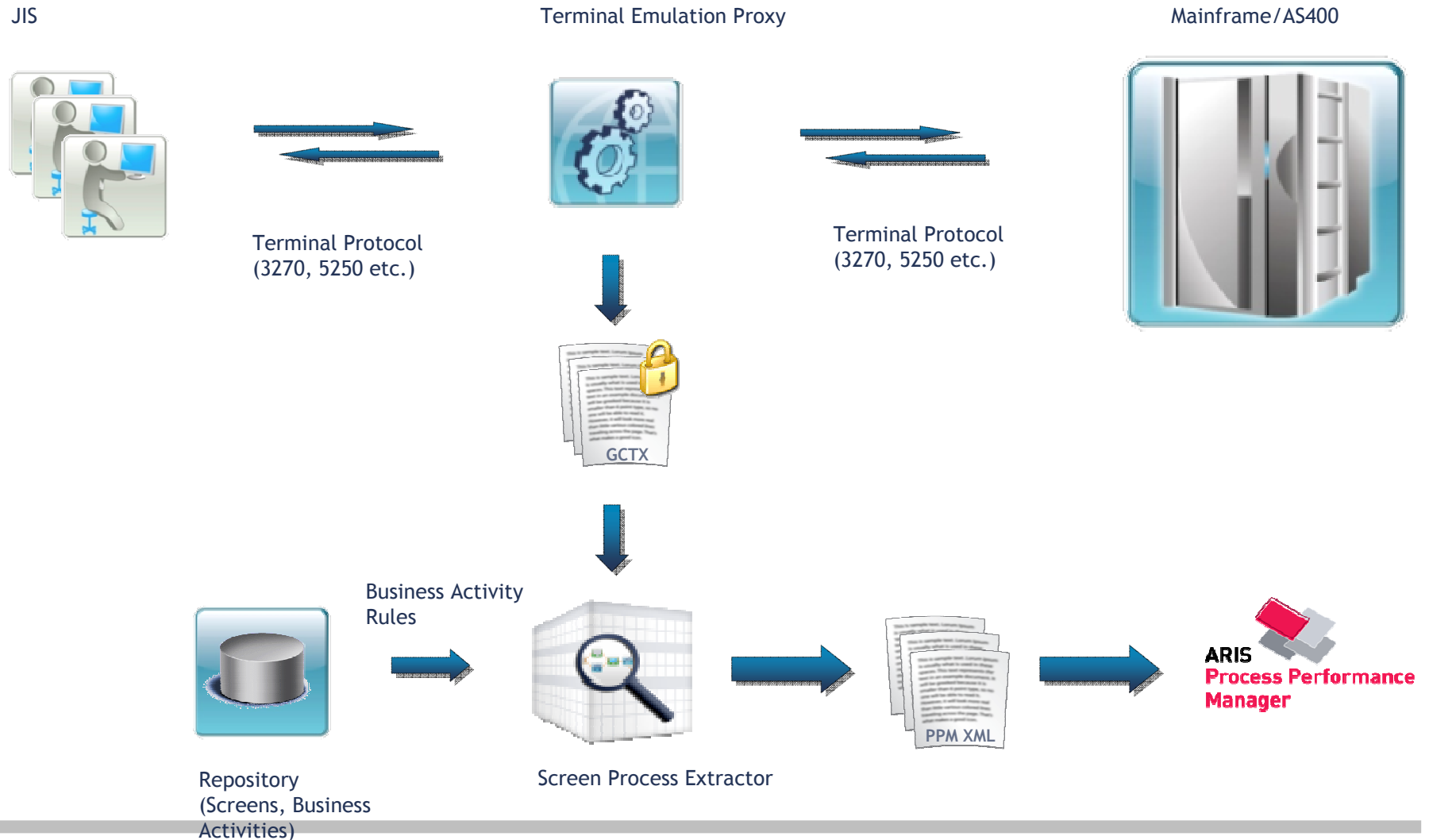
## End-to-end process view on instance level
