

Call for Nominations: 2019 APS Best Publication Award

Deadline: April 1, 2019

The Applied Probability Society of INFORMS invites nominations for its *2019 Best Publication Award*. This award, which recognizes outstanding contributions to applied probability, consists of a plaque and \$1000. It will be presented at the INFORMS Annual Meeting, Seattle, WA (October 20-23, 2019).

To be eligible, the contribution (a book, paper, or set of papers) must meet the following criteria.

- The contribution must be in the area of applied probability;
- It must have been published (in the case of a set, at least one member of the set) in the open peer reviewed literature during the interval January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2018;
- It must be written in English, or have an accurate English translation available.

The contribution is judged according to the extent to which it advances the state of the art, the theoretical or methodological originality, depth and significance, the areas of application that it opens, and the clarity of the exposition.

Nominations may be made by anyone, including the nominee. A nomination package consists of

- A description of the contribution and its significance;
- A copy of the nominated publication(s).

The nominator should send a separate package to each of the award committee members below.

Electronic submissions are highly encouraged.

Nominations submitted before 11:59pm EST on April 1, 2019, will be given full consideration.
