## MINUTES OF THE TSS MEETING, Los Angeles

Minutes of the Transportation Science Section Meeting April 25, 1995 at the INFORMS Annual Meeting, Los Angeles

Informal discussions in this regard have focused on ways of coordinating efforts across these areas; perhaps a larger umbrella organization may be created. Marius was given extra thanks for working with the New Orleans program committee to optimize the scheduling of TSS sessions at the meeting. 10. Upcoming activities were announced.
