

• Dues- effective 2019: INFORMS members \$7, non-members 10\$, retired members \$5, student members \$2.







MCDM Junior Researcher Best Paper Award



- recognizes outstanding papers in the field of MCDM written by a junior researcher or a team of junior researchers.
- seeks novelty in theoretical, methodological, or applied research in the area of MCDM; relevance to real-life applications; potential impact of the obtained results on society.
- was given for the first time in 2018.



Qualifying for the Award in 2019

- A candidate must be the single author or the leading coauthor of an article.
 A team of candidates must consist of the leading coauthors of an article.
- The article must be written in the English language and published electronically in a peer-reviewed journal within the period between the 1st of January 2016 and the 1st of January 2019.
- All candidates must be within seven years of their Ph.D. graduation by the 1st of January 2019.
- All candidates must be members of the MCDM Section.
- All candidates must be nominated by an MCDM Section member.
- Executive Board members are the judges.
- Three finalists present their papers in the award session.
- The winner receives a cash award of \$500.


Action Items for 2020

 - PI's ?




