## Introduction

Victoria's state government established the *Professional Engineers Registration Act 2019* on 1 July 2021.

The PER Act regulates anyone who provides a 'professional engineering service' and is administered by Consumer Affairs Victoria.

Subject to individuals meeting the prescribed qualification, experience, competence and probity requirements they are registered for a 3-year period that requires triennial renewal.

#### **Position**

IPWEA Victoria is an engineering association with a commitment to enabling better public works. Many of its members are registered engineers in the civil area since becoming subject to the Act on 1 October 2022.

IPWEAV supported advocacy for the Act by Engineers Australia and Professionals Australia from 2015-2021 and supports its operation through the following services:

# Registration

By assessing the qualification, experience and competence of aspiring registrants under a BLA-approved Assessment Scheme (since July 2021).

### Renewal

By verifying compliance with the Continuing Professional Development obligations of RPEVs (commencing in 2025).

## **Statement**

IPWEAV will maintain its support for the regulation of civil engineers to ensure optimal infrastructure outcomes by advocating:

#### Registration

- That suitably qualified and experienced civil engineers be supported by their employer to become registered, meet their prescribed CPD obligations and renew their registration
- That unregistered individuals be cautioned against the risks of providing engineering advice without the supervision or guidance of a registered engineer
- That a statewide employer audit be undertaken to verify the compliance of engineering and allied professional staff

#### Renewal

 That the co-regulatory model adopted for registration also be adopted for registration renewal to enhance consumer protection
