Government: oversight, establishment and assurance of efficiency

### BLA

Operates enforcement regime, keeps central register, and other aspects of legislation

Business Licensing Authority approves assessment schemes operated by professional associations and industry

### Associations

Conduct assessments

Maintain Code of Conduct, ensure CPD and assess ongoing competence

Liaise with Business Licensing Authority

### Enforcement

The Business Licensing Authority, Consumer Affairs and the Victorian Building Authority are enforcing entities

### Engineers

Engineers can only be engaged to perform an engineering service if they are registered unless working under supervision.
