Re-building bridges...InQuik time!

During the recent NSW bushfires some 60 council-owned bridges were burnt or damaged with the Currowan fire destroying 4 bridges on Shoalhaven Council's road network.

Two of the major bridges were School Ck – a 16m bridge 6m off the waterway with serious access issues and no semi-trailer access – and Toomoolomobah Bridge – a 24m 2 span bridge in a very remote area with limited access and a 5-tonne load limit on one side.

InQuik worked closely with Shoalhaven Council to pull together the designer and local contractors to get the projects delivered, getting access back up and running as fast as possible.
