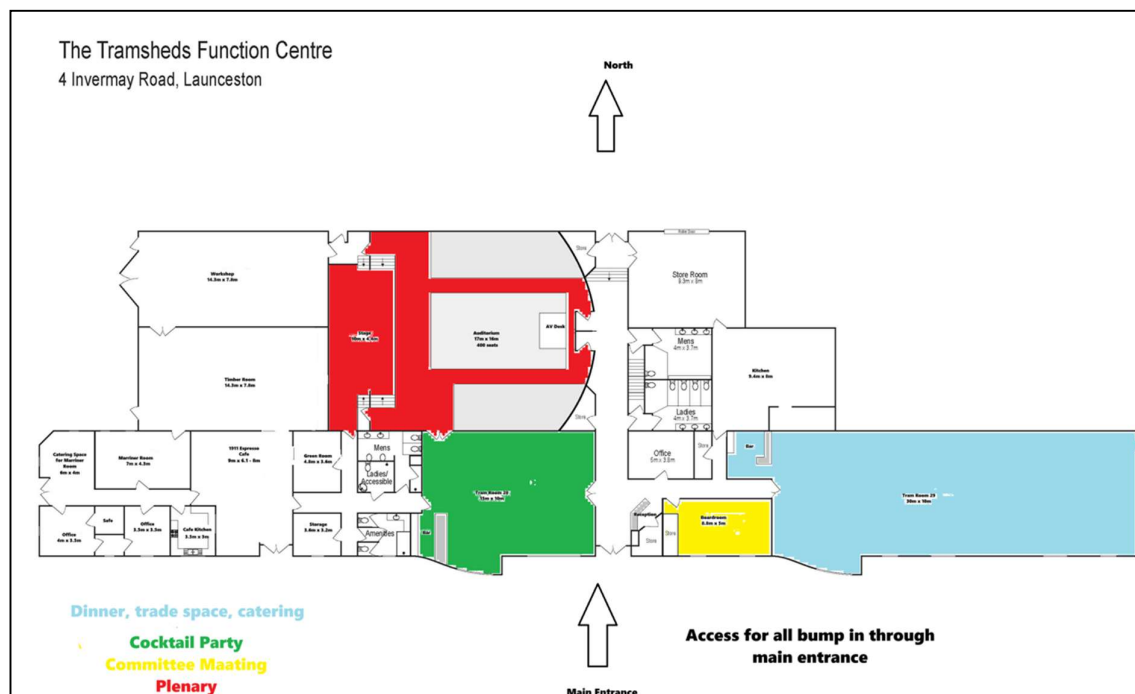

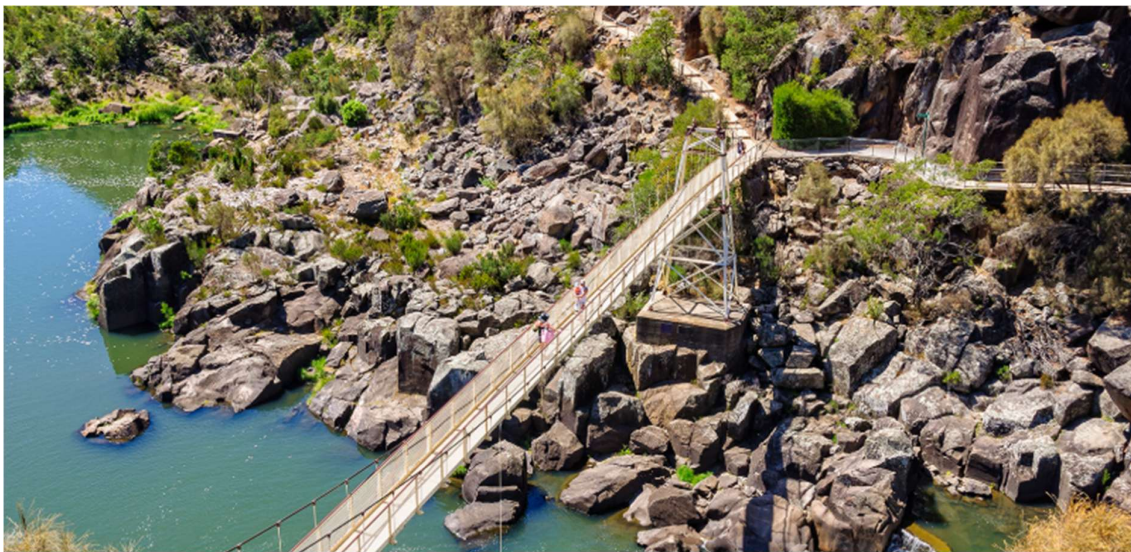
Tech Tour Saturday 15 November

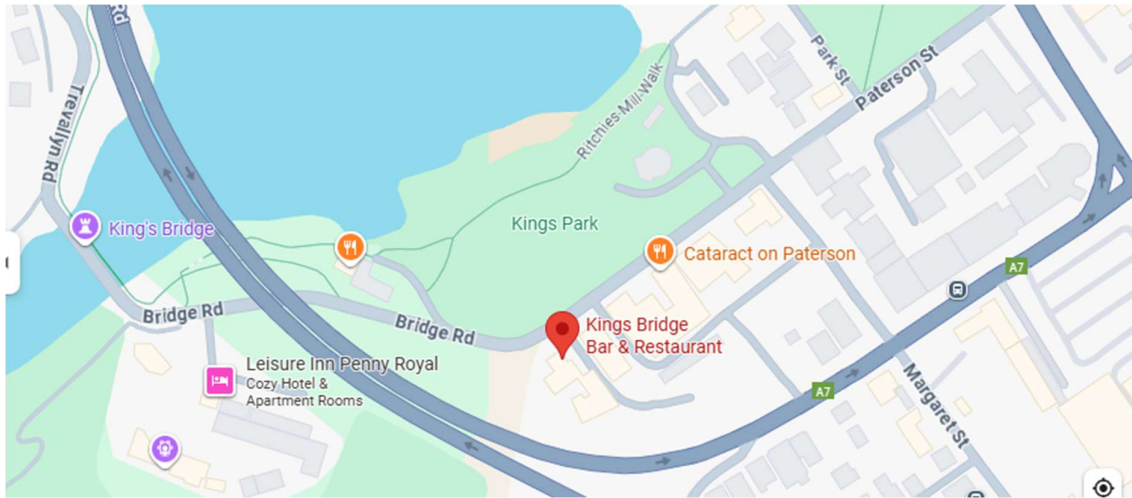
Gorge suspension bridge

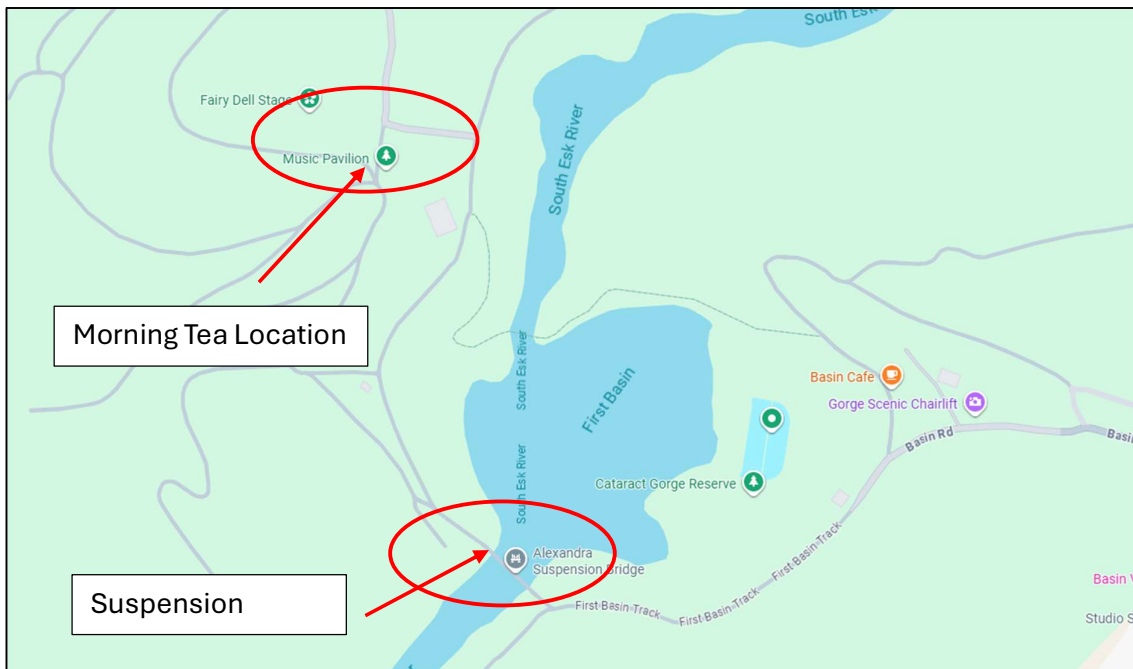
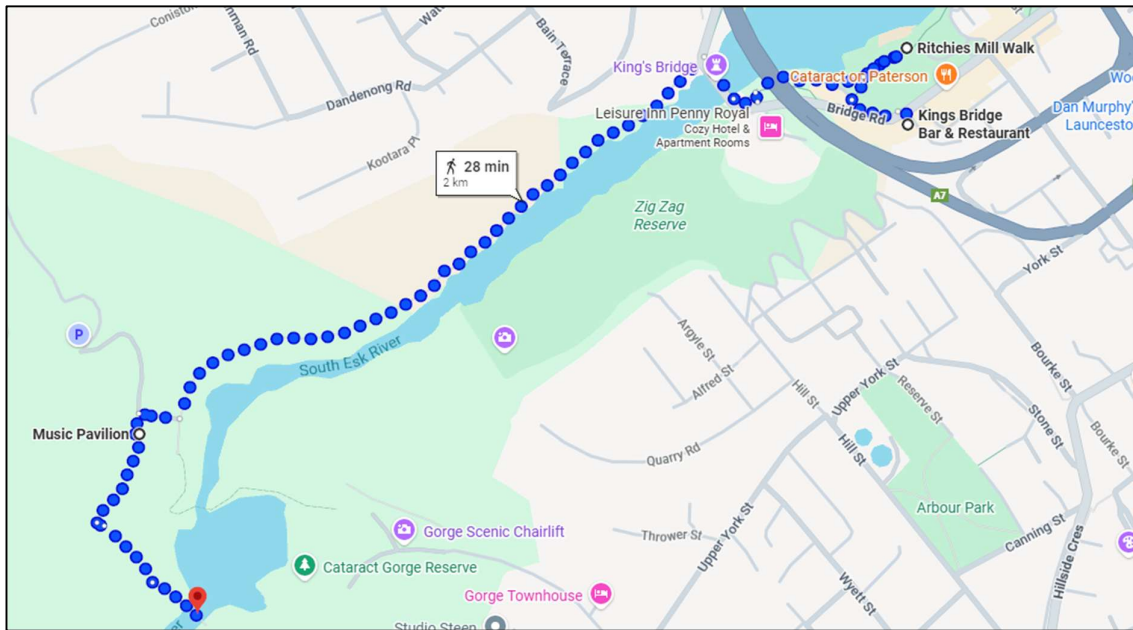
