- Professional Development Workshops held annually around Australia. Around 140 people regularly attend the series. The workshops provide fleet management training and information on new technology & products.

- In conjunction with industry partner Latus, IPWEA offers fleet operators a clear pathway to CoR compliance by introducing the Chain of Responsibility Safety Management System - CORSaMS. CORSaMS provides the materials and support necessary to meet NHVR CoR obligations. Once CORSaMS has been implemented to the required standard, IPWEA will issue a CORSaMS - Chain of Responsibility Safety Management System Certificate.
- Fleet Maintenance Safe Practice Guide (2014) provides an overview of OH&S obligations and systems, and identifies typical hazards and controls in various areas of fleet maintenance operations.
- Online Fleet Community "AskYourFleetMates" discussion forum with around 2,000 members around Australia and internationally.
- Fleet Intouch monthly e-newsletter providing important industry information.
- Additional Resources for IPWEA FLEET subscribers - with an ever increasing range of guidance notes and information available from the IPWEA website to help manage your fleet.
