

IPWEA Australasia Awards

"Keith H Wood Medal"

Call for Nominations

This medal recognises an outstanding engineer in public works, who has demonstrated exceptional dedication, leadership, and contribution to both the industry and IPWEA over some significant number of years and is worthy of the highest industry commendation. This is the most prestigious award presented by IPWEA. Recipients can only be nominated by their peers.

The award is made in honour of **Keith H Wood AM**, a founder of the Australian Local Government Engineer's Association which later became the Institute of Municipal Engineering Australia, now the Institute of Public Works Engineering Australasia (IPWEA).

Members of IPWEA who have made a significant contribution to the improvement of local government engineering and the profession are eligible for the Award. Eligibility does not preclude an engineer now acting in a Chief Executive Officer role or other capacity in the private or public sector.

Nominations must be made by one or more members of IPWEA who will provide a comprehensive curriculum vitae of the applicant and be supported by written evidence fully setting out the reasons why the nominee is being put forward. Nominations must be endorsed by the respective IPWEA Division Board and be accompanied by names and addresses of three members able to act as referees to support the nomination.

There is no requirement or obligation for every Division to make a nomination. Just as applies with Emeritus nominations, it is only the highest calibre of candidates that should be forwarded for consideration for this award.

Nominations should be in sufficient detail to ensure that the Selection Committee can assess the suitability of the nominee. Only the recipient of the award will be announced on the evening. Nominees will not be announced. The awardee, or their representative, must be in attendance at the presentation event which will be held at the IPWEA International Public Works Conference in Perth, 23 August 2017.
