

1 Utilisation	The key to procurement and management of the plant & vehicle fleet
2 Whole of life Costs	Knowing the whole of life cost and expected utilisation provides charge out rates that recover the full cost of owning & operating the item
3 Tendering	Preparing the specification and assessing tenders through a weighted analysis aimed at delivering a best value outcome
4 Maintenance	Best practice maintenance includes scheduling services, assessing the reason for failures and maintenance chain of responsibility.
5. Service level agreements	Provide the framework upon which works and services are delivered
6 Regulatory Requirements	Operating plant and fleet attracts inherent liabilities for an organisation directly related to various regulatory requirements
