Since the opening of the NOTE-registry in 2014 we have made excellent progress. **615** patients with congenital heart disease on NOACs have been enrolled in collaboration with **40** participating centers all over the world.

As of May 2019, **8** thromboembolisms and **9** major bleedings were reported in the registry.
