1. Enroll in [IMPACT](#)
EI Billing Provider: 7094782 EI MCO: 3000005
2. Complete [paper application](#) with Provider Connections
3. Include a copy of SLP license from the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation
4. If completing a CF, include [Early Intervention Program Acknowledgment of Supervisor Form](#)
5. Include signed [CFS 689 Authorization For Background Check Form](#)
6. Include signed agreement to participate in [Ongoing Professional Development Plan Form](#)
7. Include [Consultation Verification Form](#) documenting 120 hours of experience with infants/toddlers & their families while in consultation with a credentialed EI SLP OR complete within the 18-month temporary credential period
8. Include documentation of [Early Intervention System Overview Training](#)
