



STEPS TO OBTAIN AUDIOLOGY IDFPR LICENSURE

For applicants who hold a valid Audiology license in another state and/or have their ASHA CCC

1. Download and complete [IDFPR application](#)
2. Follow instructions for licensure by Endorsement of Licensure Profession Code: 147
3. Complete CAA form (regardless of criminal background)
4. Complete top portion of CT form & send to state licensing board for your initial and current license
5. Complete top portion of ED form & send to your graduate school
6. Complete VE form only if your professional experience was NOT part of your graduate program & send Praxis Scores OR Send copy of your ASHA CCC
7. Mail completed application packet with returned CT and ED forms and a \$145.00 check payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation

For applicants who do not hold a valid aud license in another state and/or do not have their ASHA CCCS (e.g., Recent graduates)

1. Download and complete [IDFPR application](#)
2. Follow instructions for licensure by Acceptance of Examination Profession Code: 147
3. Complete CAA form (regardless of criminal background)
4. Send Praxis Scores (test code 5343) to IDFPR
5. Complete top portion of ED form & send to your graduate school. *IL graduates contact your program director
6. Complete VE form only if your professional experience was NOT part of your graduate program
7. Mail completed application packet with returned CT and ED forms and a \$135.00 check payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation
