



STEPS TO OBTAIN SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY IDFPR LICENSURE

For applicants who hold a valid license to practice speech-language pathology in another state and/or have their ASHA CCCs

1. Download and fill out [IDFPR Application](#)
2. Follow instructions for licensure by endorsement of Licensure Profession code: 146
3. Complete CAA form (regardless of criminal background)
4. Complete top portion of CT form & send to state licensing board for your initial and current license
5. Complete top portion of ED form & send to graduate school
6. Complete VE form & send Praxis scores or copy of ASHA CCC
8. Mail completed packet with returned CT & ED forms & a \$100 check payable to the Illinois Department of Financial & Professional Regulation

For applicants who do not hold a valid license in another state and/or do not have their ASHA CCCs (e.g. recent graduates)

1. Download and fill out [IDFPR Application](#) for BOTH temporary & full state license
2. Follow instructions for licensure by Acceptance of Examination & licensure by Temporary License (TP-SLP). Profession Code: 146
3. [Ask ETS](#) to send Praxis scores (test code 5331) to IDFPR
4. Complete CAA form (regardless of criminal background)
5. Complete top portion of ED form & send to graduate school
*IL graduates contact your program director
6. Mail VE form to IDFPR after CF completion
7. Mail completed application, CAA form, and \$165 check payable to the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation
