

Rising Star Award for New Chapters

The Rising Star Award recognizes new chapters that demonstrate outstanding management and programming in their first biennium following installation.

Eligibility

Chapters must meet the requirements:

- Chapters must have been active for 1 to 3 full academic year(s) to qualify.
- Chapter must have held one initiation per year.
- Chapter must have completed and submitted the Chapter Affiliation Agreement on time.
- Chapter must show at least 1 year of programs and activities.

Criteria

All submissions must include the following prerequisite information, in addition to specific program criteria:

- **Chapter Experience.** Provide highlights of how the chapter has engaged their members since their installation—providing member involvement opportunities, gaining insight on what members want by surveying, celebrating one another's achievements, and preparing them for post-graduation life.
- Membership Growth. Document general membership meetings with attendance and describe how the chapter uses resources from KDP to communicate benefits and services to its membership. Describe the chapter's recruitment strategy for new members.
- Chapter Leadership. Document chapter officers currently in place, describe officer training conducted and/or participated in and describe leadership development and networking opportunities for the general membership.
- Chapter Programs. Document one year of programs from July 1 to June 30. Choose two
 categories from the following: community service, professional development, membership, or
 fundraising. Describe one program for each category chosen. Be able to include title, dates,
 overall attendance, and description of the impact of the program.
- **Future Planning.** Describe how you have used what you have learned since installation to plan better programs and improve the recruitment process.

Submission Requirements

A complete online submission will the following elements:

- Online entry form
- Validation of chapter report submissions
- Description for each criteria area of program categories; and supplemental documents to support the narrative.
