

Chapter Program Awards

The Program Awards recognize chapters for demonstrating excellence in a program area. Programs submitted as part of the ACE (Achieving Chapter Excellence) award application may not be submitted for an individual Chapter Program Award in the same year.

Eligibility

Chapters must meet the requirements for an active chapter:

- Chapters have held an initiation and submitted the Chapter Affiliation Agreement by the deadline for the previous academic year.
- Programs must have been completed during the same academic year.
- Chapters can submit one eligible program per category.
- Chapters are eligible to win in two categories per academic year.

Criteria

Entries must be in one of the following categories:

- Celebration of Teaching
- Community Service
- Fundraising
- Leadership Development

- Literacy Alive!
- Professional Development

Narrative Requirements

All submissions must include the following prerequisite information, in addition to specific program criteria:

- **Description of Program:** Outline the program(s), including participant(s) and volunteer information, and an overview of the program.
- Planning and Depth of Program: Detail the program planning outline. Include budget, leader names, and marketing information (if necessary). Program is required to be memberdriven, in-depth, and long-term and/or ongoing.
- **Objectives and Expected Outcomes:** Clearly defined objectives/goals, including information as to why the program was chosen. Discuss the expected outcomes of program, including feedback/testimonials with data and/or quotes.
- **Impact:** Discuss the benefits of the program for participants and planners, including feedback and data. What did participants and members learn throughout the process?
- **Evaluation:** Evaluate the outcomes and discuss how they compare with the program goals and what can be improved. How will the chapter use what has been learned to move forward as a group and/or as educators?
- Bonus Points:
 - Creativity of project 3 points
 - Project is new to the chapter 3 points
- ♦ Video/creative submission 5 points
- Includes alumni 3 points
- A complete online submission will consist of:
 - Online entry form.
 - Supporting narrative meeting the requirements listed above (up to two pages, single spaced) or otherwise creative entry; and
 - Up to three documents supporting narrative.
