Some Reminders about the Conference:

- It will be taking place this Sunday, March 23rd, from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- Check-in will begin and light breakfast refreshments will be served starting at 10:30 am.
- Lunch will be pasta primavera, artisanal sandwiches, and house made chips. Vegetarian options will be available.
- The dress code is business casual.
- Feel free to bring a laptop and/or notebook and pen for note taking.

How to Get to the Conference:

- Our conference is taking place on the St. John's University Queens campus at 8000 Utopia Pkwy, Queens, NY 11439. This will bring you to Gate 1 (G1 on the map).
- If parking you can ask a public safety officer for a free temporary parking pass, saying you are here for a conference in the D'Angelo Center. You may park in the yellow general parking lot next to Gate 1.
- If you are taking public transit and arrive via the Q30/31, it will drop you off right near Gate 1 as well.
- You are welcome to utilize free street parking by gates closer to the building as well (marked G4, G5, and G6) and walk on to campus.
- You can use the map to guide you to the D'Angelo Center (A black dot with #12).
- If lost, feel free to stop any student and ask where the D'Angelo Center is and they should point you in the right direction. It is the building with the bell tower on top of it!
- Once in the D'Angelo Center, take the elevator or stairs to the fourth floor, to the D'Angelo Center Ballroom (DAC 416C) to check in.
