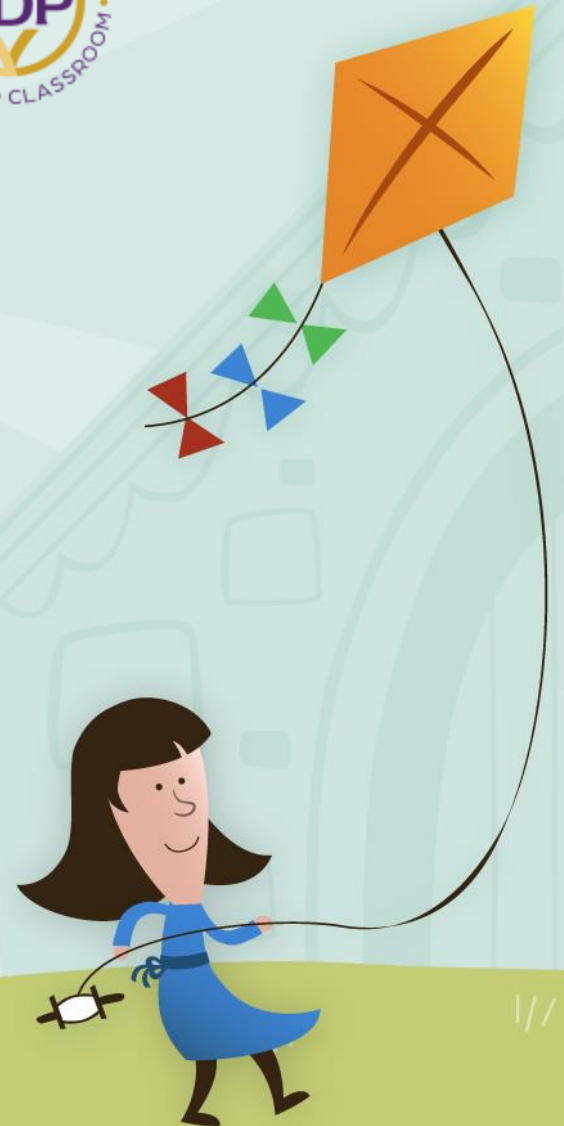

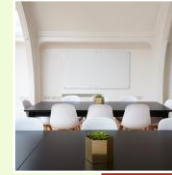
Preparation

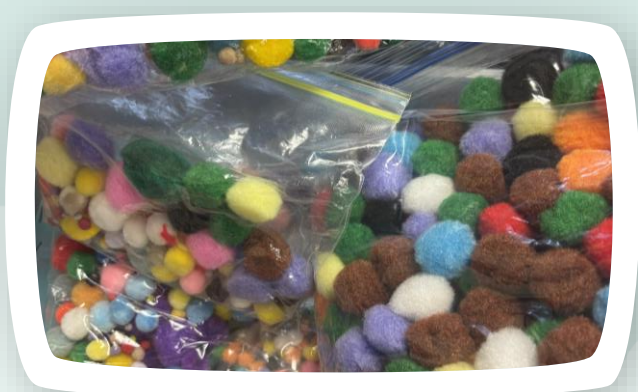
Use the sample in Google Classroom
