










Connecting, Restoring and Protecting Koalas on the Sunshine Coast Hinterland

Learnings

- ✓ Landholders engagement = high survival rates of trees
- ✓ Groups of landholders = helps build wildlife corridors
- ✓ Upskilling landholders = more trees planted
- ✓ Lantana removal = koalas moving across the landscape
- Cultural knowledge helped to boost our understanding of the landscape





- 5.5 hectares area revegetated
- 17.6 hectares of invasive weeds removed
- Lantana treated on 20 properties to improve habitat quality to facilitate koala movement across the landscape for food and mates
- 1799 hours of volunteer labour contributed to koala habitat restoration
- ✓ Worked with 35 landholders
- 2 education events for landholders and community members
- ✓ 1 partnership with local indigenous group – Bunya Bunya Country Aboriginal Corporation
