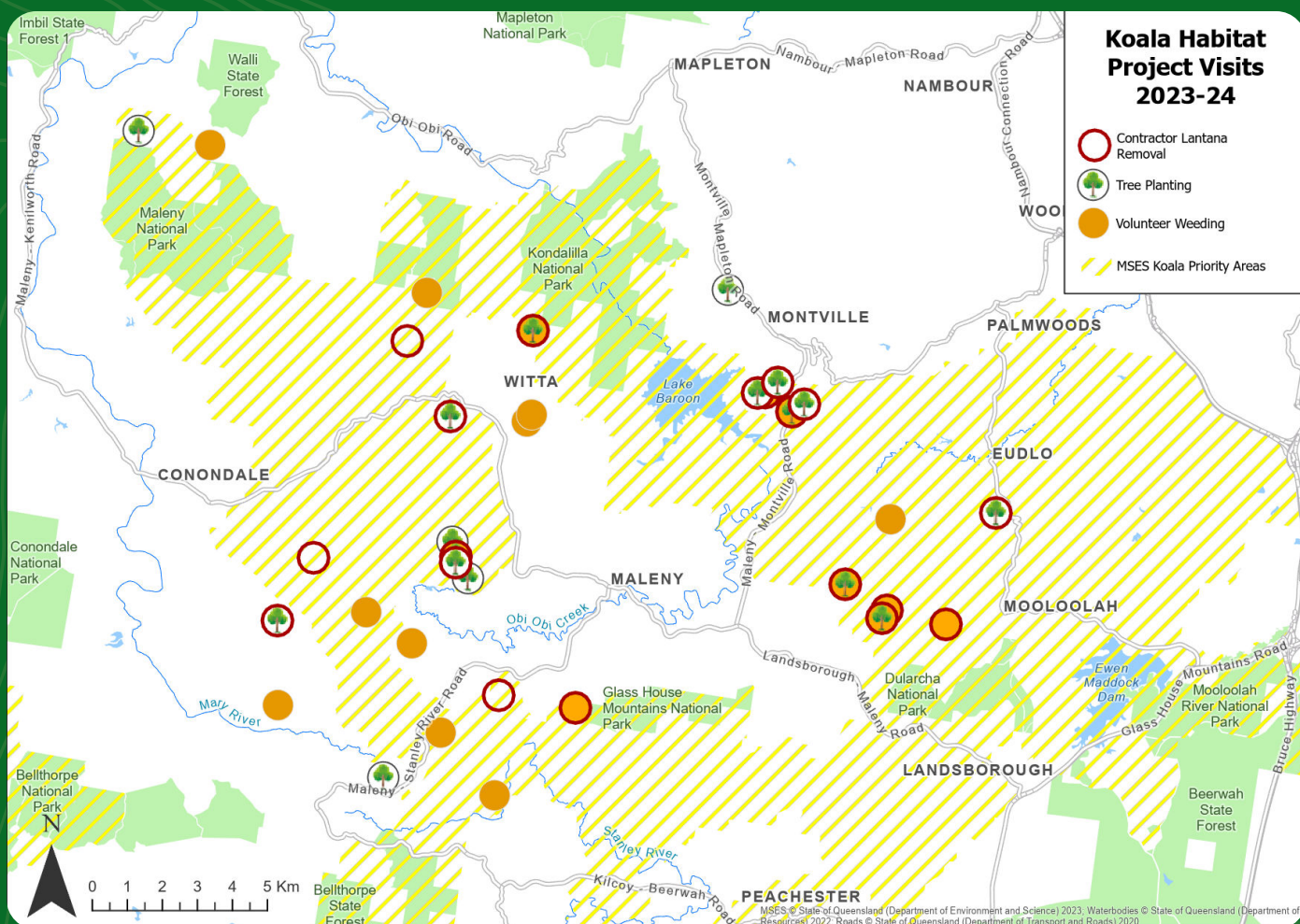




Learnings

- ✓ Landholders engagement = high survival rates of trees
- ✓ Groups of landholders = helps build wildlife corridors
- ✓ Upskilling landholders = more trees planted
- ✓ Lantana removal = koalas moving across the landscape
- ✓ Cultural knowledge helped to boost our understanding of the landscape
- ✓ Kids love planting trees for koalas!



- ✓ 5140 trees planted
- ✓ 5.5 hectares area revegetated
- ✓ 17.6 hectares of invasive weeds removed
- ✓ Lantana treated on 20 properties to improve habitat quality to facilitate koala movement across the landscape for food and mates
- ✓ 1799 hours of volunteer labour contributed to koala habitat restoration
- ✓ Worked with 35 landholders
- ✓ 38 community volunteer events
- ✓ 2 education events for landholders and community members
- ✓ 1 partnership with local indigenous group – Bunya Bunya Country Aboriginal Corporation
