

Driving Fish Habitat Action

An OzFish and Landcare NSW Partnership



Since 2020, OzFish chapters and Landcare groups across NSW have come together to scale up fish habitat restoration activities and improve their local waterways.

Landcare NSW and OzFish have joined forces over the last five years to initiate 100 partnership projects across the state, empowering grassroots Landcare groups to collaborate with recreational fishers on local fish habitat restoration projects.



KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

-  **5 years of partnership.**
-  **Partnership projects on 100 creeks and rivers in NSW.**
-  **63,795 native trees and shrubs planted.**
-  **100km of riverbank restored.**
-  **198 habitat structures for native fish installed.**
-  **1000s of hours of volunteer time.**

A diverse range of partnership projects have been undertaken in both freshwater and saltwater ecosystems with financial support from the NSW Recreational Fishing Trust and BCF Boating Camping Fishing stores.

The results prove that collaborations between OzFish chapters and Landcare groups result in fish habitat restoration outcomes that are greater than the sum of their parts.
