The Biodiversity Collage is an interactive, science-based workshop that boosts biodiversity literacy by helping participants explore ecosystem relationships, human impact, and biodiversity loss.

Based on IPBES reports, it equips diverse audiences to integrate biodiversity into decision-making and foster a deeper commitment to protecting nature.

WHY IT MATTERS

- Help visualise ecosystem interconnections
- Highlights the human role in biodiversity decline
- Encourages collective, systems-based thinking
- Catalyses conservation awareness and action

METHODOLOGY

- Science-based: Rooted in IPBES data
- Interactive: Participants co-create a “collage” of ecosystem relationships
- Collaborative: Built on group reflection and dialogue
- Scalable: Uses a train-the-trainer model for exponential reach
