

# 1. Significant Committee Actions/Accomplishments

- Domestic Violence and ADR The committee presented on the domestic violence screening protocol at the annual state bar meeting. Because of the continued feedback from the bar, that the DV screening is not actively or accurately being used, this has been a continuing project for our committee. The committee has continued to present open table discussions throughout the state, the efforts to continue in the fall. The goal is to educate and ensure that this is a standard practice throughout the state, in all counties, in mediation. Now, with the recent enactment of PA 93, these endeavors to ensure that the DV screening is utilized is of even greater importance. The enactment of PA 93 has also given us more opportunity to spread the word and continue our efforts of public education regarding the screening protocol. This continues to be an ongoing project for the committee.
- Mandatory (Automatic) Mediation The ADR Section of the Michigan State Bar has drafted a statute proposing mandatory mediation in various practice areas, including domestic relations. This statute has been reviewed by the ADR Committee of the FLS and they are working with the ADR Section on this endeavor with input from the Domestic Violence Committee of the Family Law Section.
- Friend of the Court ADR, Parent Coordination Act Training, Collaborative Court Rules, Family Law Case Captions—The ADR Committee continues to be involved, monitoring these committees, with several members working on the various task forces or committees as described herein with input of the ADR members.
