Legislative issues:

Legislative efforts are a priority of the Section. The Section is both proactive and responsive to legislative efforts and employs Public Affairs Associates, of Lansing, as its lobbyist.

The Section submitted public policy positions concerning the following legislation and/or Court Rules:

The Section opposed SB 465 (S-1) Draft 2 and SB 466 (S-1) Draft 1, as well as the proposed companion amendment to the "Security Freeze Act," in part because the proposed legislation has not been sufficiently reviewed and analyzed to ensure that the core concepts expressed by these Bills will actually result without causing unintended and undesirable changes to current Michigan guardian and conservator laws.

The Section supported with amendments HB 5366 – HB 5370, SB 0293 concerning fiduciary access to digital assets. While the Section supported these bills in concept, we believe that fiduciary access to digital assets is best accomplished in a standalone bill, rather than in various Michigan statutes. The Section drafted a proposed "Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act" which is based upon the Uniform Law Commission's act of the same name.

The Section opposed changes to MCR 7.215© proposed in ADM 2014-09 concerning the treatment of unpublished opinions.

The Council's proposed changes to Michigan Court Rules contained in ADM 2013-29, supported during the previous Council term were adopted by the Supreme Court.

Furthermore, the Section sought to influence and support the following legislation:

The Council drafted and proposed to the Michigan Legislature amendments to MCL 211.27a concerning relief from property tax uncapping in common estate planning transactions.

The Council drafted and proposed to the Michigan Legislature a Qualified Dispositions in Trust Act (otherwise known as domestic asset protection trusts) which would allow an individual grantor to protect certain dispositions in trust from particular creditor attachment.

The Council continues to support a stand-alone Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act which was drafted and approved by Council in the prior fiscal year.

The Council continues to support legislation that would restructure appeals from Probate Court.

The Section has an interest in and has been or continues to be engaging in discussion on the following:

Legislation that, under certain circumstances, would provide exculpation of trustees of life insurance trusts from liability related to the administration of life insurance policies held in the trust, which would be a proposed amendment to MCL 700.1513

Legislation to address issues of succession in matters involving artificial reproductive technology

The concept of pre-death probate of wills and trusts

Modernizing the definition of tenants by the entirety property in Michigan and extending such protection to trusts

The concept of community property trusts

Other Activities/Information:

- Sebastian V. Grassi, a former Council Member and prolific author, was awarded the Section's prestigious Michael W. Irish Award for his many contributions to the Section and to his community. Past recipients of the Michael W. Irish award are now posted on the Section's website.
- Amendments to the Section Bylaws were adopted at the Section Annual Meeting September 6, 2014 and were subsequently approved by the Board of Commissioners. The new Bylaws update the Section's mission statement, the terms for Section Council Officers consistent with the fiscal year, the criteria for Section membership, and the procedure for future Amendment of the Bylaws, among other changes.
- The Section's Citizens' Outreach Committee updated several of the Section's pamphlets and is working on a substantial revision to pamphlet content as it explores a web-based informational tool for the public on probate and estate planning matters.
- The Section voted to provide one-time support to the Solo and Small Firm Institute which will be held in October 2015
- The Section's Court Rules and Forms Committee continues to review and draft proposed improvements to SCAO forms.
- The Section continues to produce a Journal tri-annually with articles of interest to Section members. The Section transitioned to a solely electronic version of the Journal in December.
- The Section continues to review the Estates and Protected Individuals Code for possible amendments.
- The Section's newly established Membership Committee implemented several initiatives to build relationships with current Members and attract new Members. The Membership Committee held a networking event in Traverse City in May for new attorneys, new Members to the Section, non-Members and those desiring greater involvement in the Section. The Section also held a vendor booth at the annual Probate & Estate Planning Institute in May to disseminate Section information and anticipates having a booth at the SBM Annual meeting in the Fall.
- The Section established a "Join a Committee" link on Section webpage to encourage involvement of Section Members in Section legislative and leadership activities
- The Section sent its Chair Elect and Vice Chair to State Bar Leadership Forum in June 2014. It will send its Chair Elect and Vice Chair to the Forum in June 2015.

The Section's Membership dues will not increase in the 2015-2016 fiscal year.
