

Public Policy Position
Michigan Attorney General's Initiative on Robo Calls

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is a voluntary membership section of the State Bar of Michigan, comprised of 1,132 members. The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Elder Law & Disability Rights Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. To date, the State Bar does not have a position on this item.

The Elder Law & Disability Rights Section has a public policy decision-making body with 20 members. On November 2, 2019, the Section adopted its position after a discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 15 members voted in favor of the Section's position on the Michigan Attorney General's Initiative on Robo Calls, 0 members voted against this position, 0 members abstained, 5 members did not vote.

The Elder Law and Disability Rights Section of the State Bar of Michigan supports the Michigan Attorney General's initiative on robo-calls without currently taking a position on future proposed legislation.
