Legislative issues: The Section submitted public policy positions opposing proposed amendments to MCR 2-203 and to MRPC 7.3

Recommendations for next Council: The next council should continue to actively review and take public policy positions on proposed court rule amendments and legislation. The current council, under the leadership of the Legislative/Rules Committee, chaired by Michael Donnelly and Daniel McGlynn, has done a fine job of bringing before the council proposals that deserve its attention, resulting in two well-reasoned positions. The next council should build on their success.

There is one nagging issue that the next council should address head on and resolve – developing a method for ensuring that the Section acquires articles for its Newsletter well in advance of the deadline. The Newsletter has been vastly improved in recent years under the leadership of Dari Bargy who is the chair of the Publications Committee and Secretary of the Section. She has acquired many fine articles for the publication. Obtaining those articles, however, has not been easy. Some Sections has addressed this problem by

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requiring council members to write or otherwise obtain an article each year. The Litigation Section has declined to talk that action, and needs to explore other ways of ensuring a steady stream of quality articles.

Other Information: The Section donated \$4,000 to the Michigan High School Mock Trial Tournament and is currently conducting a fundraiser for the Access to Justice Fund.
