

## Public Policy Position Amicus Brief in Selliman v. Colton

The Negligence Law Section is a voluntary membership section of the State Bar of Michigan, comprised of 1,851 members. The Negligence Law Section is not the State Bar of Michigan and the position expressed herein is that of the Negligence Law Section only and not the State Bar of Michigan. To date, the State Bar does not have a position on this item.

The Negligence Law Section has a public policy decision-making body with 15 members. On January 25, 2023, the Section adopted its position after a discussion and vote at a scheduled meeting. 13 members voted in favor of the Section's position, 0 members voted against this position, 0 members abstained, 3 members did not vote.
