Bar Dues

Chair Flynn stated State Bar Dues will be increased to \$5. Therefore the dues will now be \$35 per year.

Treasurer's Report

Jayson Chizick noted there was a decrease of 9% membership. Spending, however, stays constant. We currently have approximately \$63,000 in our treasury. We have 496 members currently; of which 29 are law students and 43 are free. Increasing membership is being encouraged.

Secretary's Report.

Rosa Bava informed the group where to obtain Council Minutes at the State Bar site. This was the last meeting to be recorded by her and she thanked the Section for the honor of doing so.

Chief Magistrate Luke McMurray

Magistrate Luke McMurray stated that he is receiving good feedback about the 3 new magistrates. Ten of the 14 magistrates were full partners. There are no closing of any hearing sites contemplated. There are changes in organization. LEO will now be the new section rather than MAHS. The Board of Magistrates will be with the WC Agency. The Appellate Commission will be separate. There may be a new Director for Workers' Compensation and possible a new director for LEO. It is unclear if the MAHS rules will continue to apply.
