Cathy Gallagher is the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Diversion Program Manager (DPM) of the Detroit Division, overseeing the Diversion Program in Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky. DPM Gallagher began her career with DEA in 1985 as a Diversion Investigator, conducting inspections and investigations of DEA registrants in Baltimore and Washington, DC. She has since served at DEA Headquarters as Associate and Chief of the Liaison and Policy Section of the Diversion Control Division, where she supported DEA's mission by designing and proposing national legislation; providing leadership and advice on state legislation and regulatory initiatives; liaising with industry and their representative associations as well as the DEA's regulatory and law enforcement counterparts at the federal, state and local levels. DPM Gallagher also worked as the Chief of the Regulatory Section of the Diversion Control Division, supervising the Regulatory and Import/Export Units, which monitors the import/export program for controlled substances and listed chemicals.
